# **MINI HOT DOG**

# INGREDIENT MEASURE (FOR 100 SERVINGS)

Frankfurter, 3.5", 1 oz., #1052	200 frankfurters
Buns, Hot Dog, WG, Mini, #1236	200 mini hot dog buns (1 ounce)

#### **DIRECTIONS**

## COOKING METHODS:

To steam frankfurters:

- Place thawed frankfurters in perforated steamtable pans.
- Steam them for 2 4 minutes. (If using solid steamtable pans, additional cooking may be required.)

## To boil frankfurters:

- Bring 1 gallon of water to a boil.
- Place 50 thawed frankfurters in boiling water.
- Reduce the heat to simmer. Then simmer the hotdogs for 10 minutes.
- Drain the liquid and transfer the mini frankfurters to a steamtable for assembly.

CCP: Heat to 135 degrees F or higher for at least 15 seconds at the completion of the cooking process. If the manufacturer instructions on the package or case have a higher temperature, follow those recommendations.

## 2. HOT DOG ASSEMBLY METHODS:

To assemble from serving line:

- Place the hot dog buns in half-size steamtable pan (12 " x 10 " x 4").
- Place heated frankfurters in half-size steamtable pan (12 " x 10 " x 4").
- Open the hot dog buns and place cook frankfurters in the buns.
- Sandwiches may also be wrapped in deli paper, waxed paper, foil sheets, plastic wrap or placed in sandwich bags.
- Serve immediately, or cover the pan with lid, foil or plastic wrap. If foil or plastic wrap is used, cut holes in it to allow steam to escape. Place the pan in warmer until ready for service.

## To serve already assembled:

- Open hot dog buns and place cooked frankfurters in buns.
- Place hot dogs in steamtable pans (12' x 20" x 2½") lined with pan liners.
- Sandwiches may also be wrapped in deli paper, waxed paper, foil sheets, plastic wrap or placed in sandwich bags.
- Serve immediately, or cover the pan with lid, foil or plastic wrap. If foil or plastic wrap is used, cut holes in it to allow steam to escape. Place the pan in warmer until ready for service.

CCP: Hold and maintain product at a minimum temperature of 135 degrees F. Check temperature every 30 minutes.

# **MINI HOT DOG**

## **DIRECTIONS**

3. Portion 2 mini hot dogs and 2 buns per serving. Each portion provides 2 oz. eq. meat/meat alternate and 2 oz. eq. whole grains.

Two hot dogs may also be wrapped in deli paper, waxed paper, foil sheets, plastic wrap, or placed in sandwich bags. Place in steamtable pans.

Serve immediately, or cover the pan with a lid, foil, or plastic wrap. If foil or plastic wrap is used, cut holes in it to allow steam to escape. Place the pan in the warmer until ready for service.

CCP: Hold and maintain the product at a minimum temperature of 135 degrees F or higher. Check temperature every 30 minutes. Unassembled leftovers should be covered, labeled, and dated. Quick chill within 2 hours to 70 degrees F or lower and from 70 to 41 degrees F or lower within an additional 4 hours. Leftover assembled sandwiches do not have good quality when reheated. For best quality, assembled sandwiches should be discarded.

## **SERVING NOTES**

Have condiments available for selection by students. Condiments have not been included in this nutrient analysis – remember to include them in the weekly menu nutrient analysis.
